Phase 3 of the revised federal regulations for trauma-informed care and behavioral health services challenge long term care facilities to ensure that they are fully prepared to care for residents with complex psychosocial needs. Beyond differentiating between dementia and psychiatric illness or addictions, it is critical that you and your staff have a working knowledge of the interventions and services necessary to achieve quality care for a rapidly changing population.

Barbara Speedling will use an interactive approach to offer an overview of the regulatory expectations and insight into staff recruitment, education and oversight, assessment and care planning, service development, and therapeutic activity interventions to address a broad range of behavioral health needs.
