FEMA Releases Shelter-in-Place Guidance

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) released <u>Shelter-in-Place</u> <u>Pictogram Guidance</u> for ten hazards and three building types.

The pictograms provide clear, visual guidance to the public on shelter-in-place actions classified by both hazard and building type to ensure the public takes effective protective actions when instructed to shelter-in-place during emergencies.

This guidance provides recommended interior locations for specific hazards, additional actions for protection, and the recommended duration for staying sheltered-in-place.
